For the fourth year in a row, the “Top 10” honor goes to... Alameda Municipal Power’s customers!

Customers helped AMP earn two separate Top 10 rankings from the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) for its Alameda Green program. NREL is the U.S. Department of Energy’s primary national laboratory for renewable energy and energy efficiency research.

ALAMEDA GREEN

Alameda Green gives residents and businesses the option to support renewable energy projects, like wind and solar projects. To date, the program’s participants include more than 4,000 residents and 70 businesses.

PARTICIPATION RATE GOES UP

Alamedans’ commitment to the environment helped AMP earn a top ranking for a high participation rate in 2018.

With 13 percent of AMP’s customers participating in the program in 2018, AMP earned

a 2nd place ranking on the list of national utilities with the highest green power program participation rate.

This ranking shows a jump in participation from the previous year, when AMP ranked 7th in the category.

GREEN POWER SALES

The second ranking showcases AMP’s megawatt-hour sales from Alameda Green in comparison with total utility megawatt-hour sales. AMP placed 7th with 4.7 percent of total utility megawatt-hour sales coming from Alameda Green in 2018. AMP moved up from the 9th ranking in 2017.

PLUS MORE INCENTIVES**

As part of AMP’s membership in the American Public Power Association (APPA), Alamedans qualify for thousands of dollars in rebates on 2019 Nissan LEAF models.

REBATE DETAILS

You are eligible for a \$3,500 rebate on the 2019 LEAF 40 kWh standard model and a \$2,500 rebate on the 2019 LEAF 62 kWh ePlus. The rebate offer has been extended through January 2, 2020.

FEDERAL AND STATE INCENTIVES

You can stack on federal and state incentives to lower the cost of EV ownership even more. You can get up to \$7,500 in federal tax credits for your electric vehicle purchase. Plus, California offers rebates of up to \$7,000 for buying electric vehicles.

YOU CAN ADD AMP DISCOUNTS AND REBATES

AMP offers a monthly discount on electric bills ranging from \$9 to \$21 to all customers who own electric vehicles.

AMP also offers a rebate of \$800 toward the purchase of a level 2 charger and/or installation upgrades and permitting needed to install the charger.

Level 2 charger rebates for businesses, multifamily dwellings and public agencies are also available.

HOW TO CLAIM THE PUBLIC POWER REBATE

The Nissan LEAF rebates are offered through a partnership between APPA and Nissan. Bring printed or digital copies of the flyer available at PublicPower.org/EVrebates, proof of eligible residency, and your current electric bill to your local dealer.



TAKE ADVANTAGE OF AMP'S BALANCED PAYMENT PROGRAM

With the Balanced Payment Program, AMP calculates your average billing over the previous 12 months and sets up a fixed monthly payment for you.

- The program is recommended for customers using electricity for heat in their homes and for those on fixed incomes.
- To qualify, you must have lived at your current address for at least six months, and your account must not be past due.
