## A MAJOR GREEN MILESTONE

January 2020 marks a major green milestone for Alameda: With our community-owned electric utility now providing 100% clean energy to all its customers, Alameda has joined a small group of cities leading the nation in the transition to green power.

## RANKING AMONG THE GREENEST

Among California's utilities, Alameda Municipal Power's (AMP) energy supply now ranks among the greenest. I am excited to announce that we have achieved this milestone decades ahead of California's goal of 100% clean power by 2045.

We have far surpassed PG&E, which is working toward the state's requirement to provide 60% renewable power by 2030.

## 100% Clean Energy AND Low Rates

In addition, AMP provides its clean power to residential customers at a rate that is 17% below East Bay Community

Energy's (EBCE) rate for its comparable 100% clean power mix.

## 100% CLEAN ENERGY FOR ALL

AMP is proud to provide 100% clean power for all customers – not just for those who can afford to pay extra for greener energy. Plus, when you charge your EV, you'll now be "filling up" with 100% clean power.

## A NATIONAL LEADER

AMP's energy mix – which includes geothermal and hydroelectric sources, wind power and landfill gas – puts our community on the national stage.

We are now among a handful of other American cities that have also reached their 100% clean power goals: Aspen, Burlington, Georgetown, Greensburg, Rockport and Kodiak Island.

I take great pride in AMP's success, as AMP achieved a 100% clean energy mix because of the people of Alameda. It did not occur overnight.

When a community owns its electric utility, it means it can set the standard for environmental stewardship.


Decades ago, Alamedans decided they wanted their utility to be green. Since then, AMP has become a leader in the promotion of clean and sustainable power.

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## CLIMATE ACTION AND RESILIENCY PLAN

Alameda's commitment to clean energy goes hand in hand with the goals in the city of Alameda's Climate Action and Resiliency Plan (CARP). In fact, AMP's clean power mix goes a long way toward reaching the plan's goal of lowering the community's greenhouse gas emissions to 50 percent below 2005 levels by 2030.

We have much to be proud of this coming year as we come together to address climate change in our community and set an example for the nation.



## TIME-OF-USE RATES PROPOSED FOR EV OWNERS

At its Feb. 24 meeting, the Public Utilities Board (PUB) will consider time-of-use (TOU) rates for AMP's residential customers who own electric vehicles.

The proposal for TOU rates is part of an overall initiative to make driving EVs a more viable choice for Alamedans and reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

## SAVE MONEY BY SHIFTING USE

With TOU rates, electric vehicle owners would be incentivized to save money by shifting their energy use—particularly EV charging—from peak hours to off-peak hours.

## HOW IT WORKS

If approved by the PUB, the special rate program would be optional for participants and go into effect on July 1, 2020.

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# REPLACE YOUR OLD CAR WITH A CLEAN ONE


If you're thinking about retiring your old car, there is a program that can help you replace it with a hybrid, plug-in hybrid, or battery electric vehicle, or to get a Clipper Card for public transit.

## CLEAN CARS FOR ALL PROGRAM

Income-qualified Bay Area residents may be eligible for grants from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District. Through the district's Clean Cars for All Program, eligible residents can swap out their older, more polluting cars and receive funds to purchase clean vehicles.

## EV DISCOUNT TO END ON JUNE 30

In December, the Board approved an end date of June 30, 2020 for AMP's monthly electric vehicle discount.

This discount program is being phased out as part of the transition to the TOU rate. The program will be discontinued, so it will no longer be an option, even for those who choose not to participate in TOU.
