THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS ARE AVAILABLE

As part of AMP's membership in the American Public Power Association (APPA), Alamedans qualify for thousands of dollars in rebates on 2019 Nissan LEAF models. The rebate offer has been extended through March 31, 2020.

REBATE DETAILS

You are eligible for a \$3,500 rebate on the 2019 LEAF 40 kWh standard model and a \$2,500 rebate on the 2019 LEAF 62 kWh ePlus.

FEDERAL AND STATE INCENTIVES

You can stack on federal and state incentives to lower the cost of EV ownership even more. You can get up to \$7,500 in federal tax credits for your electric vehicle purchase. Plus, California offers rebates of up to \$4,500 for buying electric vehicles.

AMP REBATES

AMP offers a rebate of \$800 toward the purchase of a level 2 charger and/or installation upgrades and permitting needed to install the charger. Level 2 charger rebates for businesses and public agencies are also available. Learn more at www.alamedamp.com
