PLUS, AMP currently offers you cash rebates on several of these appliances, including up to \$800 on Level 2 EV chargers, up to \$100 on electric dryers, and up to \$1,500 on heat pump water heaters. AMP will launch additional rebates in the coming year, including rebates for heat pump space heating, induction stoves and heat pump dryers.

Combine AMP's Rebates with Other Incentives

The savings don't stop there. AMP's rebates can be used in combination with rebates from the Bay Area Regional Energy Network (BayREN). For example, you can combine AMP's heat pump water heater rebate of up to \$1,500 with BayREN's \$1,000 incentive toward the water heater's purchase and installation.

With spring comes activities like picnicking outdoors, hiking and flying kites. But don't let the peaceful appearance of kites and balloons fool you – they can cause real trouble!

Keep Them Away From Power Lines

When a kite or metallic balloon makes contact with a power line, it can lead to power outages, fires and possible injuries.

Lessen the Risks

Here's how you can fly kites and decorate with balloons safely:



Make sure balloons are always secured to a weight that is heavy enough to prevent them from floating away.



When you're out and about, keep the balloons and kites far away from overhead utility lines and all utility equipment.
