Clean, Electric Appliances

Take the time this Earth Month to plan for your next electric appliance purchase. Here's how much cash you'll get back when you use AMP's rebates:

- Up to \$2,800: Combine heat pump water heater incentives from AMP and the Bay Area Regional Energy Network with the federal tax credit
- Up to \$2,500: Residential panel upgrade rebate
- Up to \$1,500: Used all-electric vehicle (EV) rebate
