

UPDATE TO CALIFORNIA CLEAN FUEL REWARD PROGRAM

The California Air Resources Board and electric utilities have partnered to offer a discount off the purchase or lease of an eligible new all-electric or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle.

New Reward Amount

The maximum reward amount was adjusted to \$750 as of Nov. 2, 2021.


Reward Eligibility

The reward is available to all California residents who purchase or lease an eligible vehicle through a participating retailer. There are no income or location restrictions within California, but the vehicle must be registered in California.


