Used Electric Vehicle Rebate

AMP has increased the maximum purchase price for used all-electric vehicles to be eligible for a cash rebate from \$32,000 to \$40,000. For a limited time, if you bought a used, all-electric vehicle on or after February 1, 2023, you are likely eligible for a rebate of up to \$6,000. Income Qualified Solar Rebate

Thinking about installing solar panels on your home? Starting November 1, 2022, AMP is offering a \$500 rebate for income qualified customers who are installing solar in their homes. This rebate will help offset city fees associated with installing solar in your home.

Kites and Balloons: *Not So Harmless*

With spring comes activities like picnicking outdoors, hiking and flying kites. But don't let the peaceful appearance of kites and balloons fool you – they can cause real trouble!

Keep Them Away from Power Lines

When a kite or metallic balloon makes contact with a power line, it can lead to power outages, fires and possible injuries.

Lessen the Risks

Here's how you can fly kites and decorate with balloons safely:

- Make sure balloons are always secured to a weight that is heavy enough to prevent them from floating away.
- When you're out and about, keep the balloons and kites far away from overhead utility lines and all utility equipment.
- If a kite or balloon gets caught in a power line, call AMP immediately at (510) 748-3900.
