A 1 PERCENT OVERALL RATE INCREASE

At its April 23 meeting, the Public Utilities Board (Board) approved a 1 percent overall rate increase for fiscal year 2019.

The increase, which goes into effect July 1, will help Alameda Municipal Power (AMP) prepare for projects to improve aging infrastructure, such as cables, poles, transformers and circuit breakers.

FAIR, COMPETITIVE RATES

The increase also helps AMP continue to move toward a structure that ensures fairness for all customers

by aligning the rates for each customer class with the cost of providing service.

AMP, your community-owned and locally operated electric utility, does not make a profit on rates. With the one percent increase, AMP's rates remain competitive and will average 17 percent lower than those in neighboring communities.

AVERAGE MONTHLY BILL

A typical residential customer with an average monthly bill of \$63 can expect to see an increase of approximately \$1.06 to his or her monthly bill.

SERVING THE COMMUNITY

In addition, AMP will continue to contribute to the city of Alameda's quality of life in fiscal year 2019. The revenue from electric sales goes toward operation of the electric system and then toward community services for Alamedans through AMP's annual transfer of more than \$5 million to the city's general fund.

But how can you determine whether you're speaking with an Alameda Green associate or someone from another organization? To know if you're interacting with someone from Alameda Green, just keep in mind the following:

- Alameda Green associates wear shirts and jackets that display both AMP and Alameda Green logos.
- They will tell you that they are part of an AMP program.
- The associates have AMP contractors' badges.
- For verification that a visitor is from an AMP representative, you can ask to see their badge.
