# The Flash

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What's fast, electric and green? Electric vehicle (EV) chargers, of course! AMP is excited to announce the upcoming launch of its EV charger rebate program.

## A \$500 REBATE

The rebate will ease the cost of purchasing a Level 2 charger. AMP will offer residential customers a \$500 rebate for a Level 2 home EV charger. Non-residential customers will be able to apply for a \$3,000 rebate on Level 2 chargers for the workplace.

The rebate will apply to purchases of Level 2 chargers dating back to October 16, when the Public Utilities Board (Board) approved the new program.

The program will officially launch in February.

## EV DISCOUNT PROGRAM

The new rebate offering will complement AMP's existing EV discount program. The discount is based on the weight of the vehicle. So, for example, vehicles between 750 to 1,999 pounds qualify for a discount of \$9 per month. Cars ranging from 2,000 to 4,999 pounds qualify for a discount of \$15 per month.

AMP will use California low carbon fuel standard credit (LCFS) funds to develop the program. You can find more information on AMP's EV programs at [www.alamedamp.com/ev](http://www.alamedamp.com/ev).

The Board wants to hear from you. Join the Board's strategic planning session in January and help lay the groundwork for AMP's future.



**BOARD LOOKS INTO  
SOLAR OPPORTUNITIES**

Local solar generation is on the minds of the members of the Public Utilities Board. Here are the key highlights from the Board's discussion of solar options at its October meeting:

**COMMUNITY SOLAR**

AMP is developing a program in which solar panels would be placed on the roofs of a couple of Alameda Unified School District (AUSD) sites. Under AMP's proposal, about 250 to 300 residential customers would participate in the 300 kW solar installation.

**UTILITY SCALE SOLAR**

The Board is looking into the possibility of installing a solar system paired with battery storage at Doolittle Landfill, also known as Mt. Trashmore, on Bay Farm Island. Board members showed interest in working with the Northern California Power Agency (NCPA) on developing a solar installation at that site. In addition, the Board asked AMP staff to explore Alameda Point as a possible location.
