



ALAMEDA WINS CLIMATE PROTECTION AWARD

AMP'S ENERGY SAVINGS PROGRAM

We're excited to announce that the city of Alameda recently won a national climate protection award for an Alameda Municipal Power (AMP) energy savings program.

The U.S. Conference of Mayors, in partnership with Walmart, honored Alameda with a Small City Honorable Mention in the 2017 Mayors' Climate Protection Awards in June.

The award is an example of how AMP has developed programs to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and is

helping the city meet its goals for the Local Action Plan for Climate Protection.

LEDS FOR 30,000 HOMES

The winning program encouraged all Alamedans to replace their incandescent light bulbs with more efficient LED bulbs.

For AMP's Great Light Bulb Change Out campaign in 2015, staff mailed two free LED bulbs to each of the City of Alameda's 30,000 households. The campaign was immediately followed by an LED rebate program called

LED Mania!, which essentially cut the cost of an LED in half.

The program showed Alamedans they could achieve approximately 200 kilowatt (kWh) of energy savings per lamp per year by switching from incandescent light bulbs to more efficient LEDs.



In June, the Public Utilities Board approved AMP's budget of approximately \$64 million for fiscal year (FY) 2018. Major projects for FY 2018 include:

- The rollout of Energy inView, AMP's smart-technology program
- The launch of a low-income energy savings program
- Funding to establish underground utility districts

Alameda Green matches 100% of your electricity usage. In 2016, Alameda Green was made up of the following new renewable resources averaged annually.

These figures reflect the power delivered to Alameda Green customers in 2016.

New Renewables come from generation facilities that first began commercial operation within the past 15 years. This product may include generation from facilities that were approved for extended use under a strict set of criteria by Green-e Energy and/or qualify as repowered.

For comparison, the current average mix of resources supplying Alameda Municipal Power includes: Large Hydroelectric (10%), Unspecified (69%), and Eligible Renewables (20%). This resource mix was prepared in accordance with CA State Law.

The average home in Alameda uses 330 kWh per month. (Source: Alameda Municipal Power Annual Sales Report, 2015)

4. A door hanger will let you know the installation was completed.
