RIDER UUT UTILITY USERS TAX

PURPOSE

The Utility Users Tax is imposed in compliance with Title 3, Chapter 3, Article 2, Division IX, Section 3-59 of the Alameda Municipal Code as adopted by Ordinance No. 3169 on November 8, 2016. This tax is collected on behalf of the City of Alameda.

APPLICABILITY

This tax is applied to the bills for electric and telecommunications services for all Alameda Municipal Power (AMP) customers except electric, water, gas, or municipal corporations, the United States Government and its agencies, the State of California, the County of Alameda, the City of Alameda, and other governmental entities.

RATE

7.5 percent of all charges except the Energy Resources Surcharge (see Rider ERS)

Seniors (65 and over) and low-income households may be eligible for a reduced tax rate of 5.5 percent. Qualifying individuals should contact the city's Finance Department at 747-4881 for more information and application forms.
